

KPEF MERIT-CUM-INAFFORDABILITY SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

S#	Approved Criteria
1	<p>The criteria for award of scholarship would be merit-cum- inaffordability/poverty to be determined by the Head of Public and Private Sector Institutes.</p> <p><u>The Eligible Candidates:</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Parents/Guardian income should be equal to less than Rs: 100,000/- per month b. Should have scored at least 70% marks in the last attended examination and 3.00 CGPA in each semester. c. Non-salaried persons would submit income certificate from concerned Deputy Commissioner or District Revenue Officer, clearly showing amount of total monthly income from all sources. d. Of Deceased parents will submit the death certificate duly verified from NADRA. e. Salaried persons would submit updated Monthly Pay roll duly attested by concerned Department. Retired person would submit the copy of pension slip and pension book duly attested by AG Office.
2	A student in receipt of any other scholarship will not be entitled to this scholarship unless he/she waves off his/her claim for the other scholarship. Written undertaking of student duly verified by concerned head of institute will be furnished.
3	All students of both public and private educational institutions, including those run by autonomous body which are approved by the Board of Directors of Foundation can apply for Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Education Foundation Scholarship through Head of Institution.
4	Scholarships are awarded for degree level programs approved by the Board, usually in the field of Engineering, Mathematics, Physics, Biology, Biotechnology, Bio Information, Microbiology, Statistics, Operational Research Management Science, Economics, Emerging Sciences, Commerce, IT and Computer Science.
5	Application Forms complete in all respect duly recommended for the award of scholarships by the head of concerned institution, would be forwarded to KPEF.
6	Only those students will be eligible for the award of this scholarship who are domiciled in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (settled areas within Pakistan) and studying in recognized/registered Private and Public Sector Institutes including those run by autonomous bodies within Pakistan.
7	The application Forms shall be designed and printed by Foundation as per its own requirements from time to time. Applicants shall apply for announced scholarships through online portal to their institution concerned.
8	Scholarship will be paid through cheques to the heads of institutions that will be responsible for proper disbursement and audit. The Foundation shall be authorized to counter check randomly the information given by the institutions regarding their financial status before issuance of cheques. Moreover, un-disbursed scholarship amount will be reimbursed to Foundation through crossed cheque in favour of "MD KP Education Foundation".
9	The head of institutions shall process these applications through a selection committee. However, all the institutions will be bound to invite the representative of KPEF for scholarship selection.
10	The submission of an acquaintance Roll of the awardees students will be the sole responsibility of concerned head of institution.
11	Those student already getting the scholarship who availed less than 3.00 CGPA and are unable to fulfill the criteria can continue the KPEF scholarship subject to improve the grade in upcoming semester otherwise the scholarship will be ceased and student or concerned institute will not be allowed to shift the scholarship amount to other student.
12	In case of tie in merit weight age will be give to poorer
13	No Principal/Dean of a faculty in the public/private sector shall have the authority to change names of awardees, the amount of the scholarship and the number of awardees.
14	Proper advertisement shall be given in 02 leading newspapers by KPEF and a copy of the advertisement be invariably placed on the notice boards of the educational institutions which are included in KPEF Scholarship Programs. Moreover, KPEF will also upload the advertisement in the official website.
15	KPEF Act-III of 1992 under Section 13 clause (2)(g) "the educational institution concerned shall in respect of every student to whom facility under the aforesaid provisions has been extended, allow concession in the tuition fee to the extent of twenty percent of the total fee being charged by such institution". In the light of said clause MoU must be signed with concerned institutes.
16	KP-Education Foundation will have the full authority to disagree the recommendation of the concerned selection committees.
17	KP-Education Foundation will have the authority to stop/discontinue the scholarship scheme.
